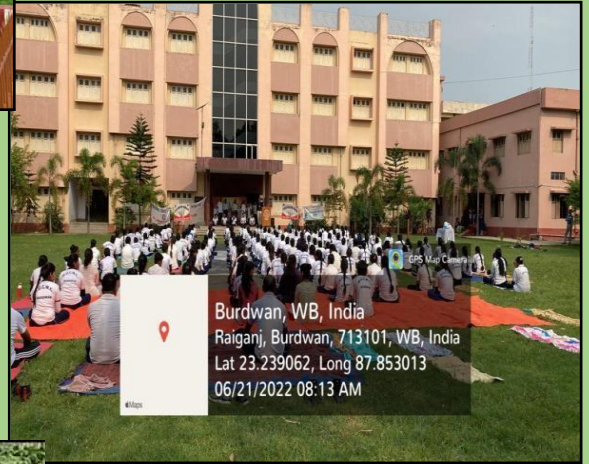

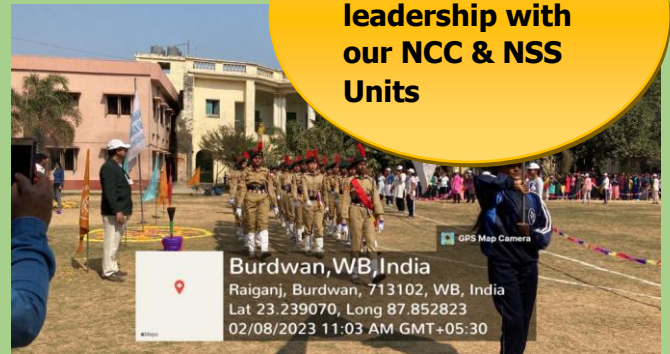
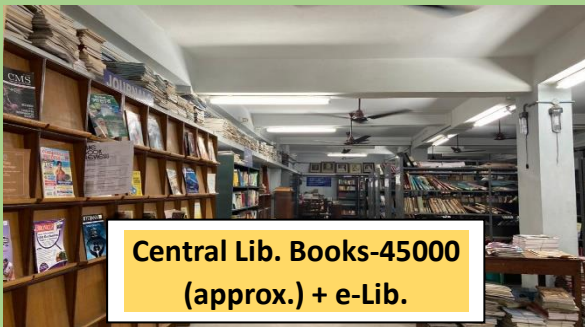

1. Admission in the 1st semester of 4-year/3-year undergraduate (UG) Hons./Degree programmes (under CCFUP as per NEP 2020) for the academic session 2024-25 will be through **Centralised Admission portal** <https://wbcap.in>; <https://banglaruchchashiksha.wb.gov.in> or <https://wbsche.wb.gov.in>
2. Candidates who have **passed 10+2/Equivalent level examination** from any recognized Council/Board/University in the year **2021/2022/2023/2024 can apply** for admission in UG SEMESTER 1. For details of rules and regulations regarding admission in UG courses, **vide Burdwan University Notification No. R-C/UG-Perm/Adm/36 dated 21/06/2024.**
3. Students **admitted in any UG Semester I course in 2023-24**, who after University Registration did not fill up form for Semester 1 Examination, **can get admission afresh (new)** in 2024-25 within available intake capacity, **retaining their old registration. They only have to fill up enrolment form.**
4. Reservation rules are as per G.O. and extant rules of Govt. of W.B.
5. Outstanding Sports person with International/National/State/District level participation certificate in sports can apply for admission to **3 Yrs. Degree Course**, if they have passed 10+2 level in aggregate.
6. Category wise Admission in Sports quota will be on the basis merit of applicants. In case of tie (equal Merit Point), the **tie will be broken by considering the marks of 1st/2nd/3rd/4th best scored subject of the candidate at 10+2/equivalent level (vide Burdwan University Notification No. R-C/UG-Perm/Adm/36 dated 21/06/2024).**
7. **In absence of affiliation and faculty Hindi cannot be taken as major/minor/language (AEC) subject.**

**HOSTEL FACILITIES in M.U.C.WOMEN'S COLLEGE

For students coming from far off places, there are **three** well-furnished **Hostels** in the **college campus** – viz., **Rokeya, Swarnakumari and Saraladevi**. Priority for accommodation is given to the students in consideration of merit and in some cases, distance. Allotment of Hostel seats is made subject wise. PWD candidates are entitled to special consideration for Hostel admission. A boarder, willing to leave Hostel after two months of Admission has to pay seat rent for one-half year.

Each Hostel has a warden and adequate number of mess-staff, CCTV, free Wi-fi, security guard. After admission and verification, hostel seats are allotted with prior notification for application

Curriculum and Credit Framework for Undergraduate Programmes (CCFUP) as per NEP 2020

Undergraduate Degree Programmes of either 3 or 4-year duration, with multiple entry and exit points and re-entry options, with appropriate certifications such as:

- a UG Certificate after completing 1 year (2 Semesters) of study in the chosen fields of study, provided that a skill based vocational course (additional 4 credits) must be completed during the summer term by the students who will exit the programme after securing 40 credits.

These students are allowed to re-enter the degree programme within three years and complete the degree programme within the stipulated maximum period of seven (7) years.

- a UG Diploma after 2 years (4 Semesters) of study, provided that a skill based vocational course (additional 4 credits) must be completed during the summer term by the students who will exit the programme after securing 83 credits. These students are allowed to re-enter the degree programme within three years and complete the degree programme within the stipulated maximum period of seven (7) years.
- a Bachelor's Degree after a 3-year (6 Semesters) programme of study,
- a Bachelor's Degree (Honours) after a 4-year (8 Semesters) programme of study. If the students complete a rigorous research project/ dissertation in their major area(s) of study in the 4th year of a bachelor's degree then (Honours with Research).

Major and Minor disciplines :

- **Major discipline** is the discipline or subject of main focus and the degree will be awarded in that discipline. Students should secure the prescribed number of credits (about 50% of total credits) through core courses in the major discipline.
- **Minor discipline** helps a student to gain a broader understanding beyond the major discipline. For example, if a student pursuing an Economics major obtains a minimum of 12 credits from a bunch of courses in Statistics, then the student will be awarded B.A. degree in Economics with a Minor in Statistics.

3-year UG Degree:

- Students who wish to undergo a 3-year UG programme will be awarded UG Degree in the Major discipline after successful completion of three years, securing 120 credits and satisfying the minimum credit requirement.

4-year UG Degree (Honours):

- A four-year UG Honours degree in the major discipline will be awarded to those who complete a four-year degree programme with 160 credits and have satisfied the credit requirements.

4-year UG Degree (Honours with Research):

- Students who secure 75% marks and above in the first six semesters and wish to undertake research at the undergraduate level can choose a research stream in the fourth year. They should do a research project or dissertation under the guidance of a faculty member of the University/College. The research project/dissertation will be in the major discipline. The students who secure 160 credits, including 12 credits from a research project/dissertation, are awarded UG Degree (Honours with Research).
